

## **Catoctin Association Policy for Youth Funds**

1. Events must be approved by the Catoctin Association Council when the event is planned.  
All Association events must meet the Council's set terms and conditions. Examples include liability and permission forms.
2. The event must be open and announced to all Catoctin Association youth.
3. The event must have a religious component.
4. The youth must report back to the Association churches, either at one of the meetings or in another approved way.
5. All participating youth must be sponsored by a Catoctin Association church that assumes some of the responsibility for funding and supervision.
6. The suggested guideline for funding is 1/3 from the individual, 1/3 from the sponsoring church, and up to a maximum of 1/3 from the Association, although the Association may decide to fund less.
7. Events that take funding priority are events open to all youth in the Association, such as the Regional Youth Event (RYE) and the National Youth Event (NYE).
